


CLEVELAND HAPPENINGS

World renown for its impressive collections, including the captivating Medieval Court, our Convention happens to also coincides with this first of its kind exhibit. *Manet & Morisot* is the first ever major exhibition dedicated to the artistic exchange between Édouard Manet, often referred to as the father of modern painting, and Berthe Morisot, the only woman among the founding members of the Impressionist movement. Through comparisons of related works made between the late 1860s and the late 1880s, this exhibition traces the evolution of a singular friendship between two groundbreaking artists. ***Regional Transit Authority public bus.***
